

DUAL STUDIES IN GERMANY

What is the programme about?

DCG supports foreign high school graduates wishing to start a dual Bachelor study programme in Germany. Dual studies consist of a scientific-related and practice-oriented part. Participants learn the theoretical parts at the university and have the possibility to transfer this knowledge into practice. The time for practice phases is agreed between the university and the company. As students are already employed by the company during their studies, they receive a salary and are entitled for vacation.

DCG works together with German universities and companies in cooperation programs to ensure students learn in a curriculum that is relevant for the German job market. For immigration to Germany DCG coordinates with German companies for a placement into a paid dual study job as well as handling the immigration process.
