Programme structure

You have finished your first year of the Master study in the field of Online Communication or Online Marketing until end of this semester. Up to 60 credits earned in this can be recognized by Anhalt University of Applied Sciences. You must study 2–3 semesters in Bernburg where you do 6–12 modules and write your Master thesis.

Mobility Semester

Option 1 Processing a task within a company, an administration at federal or

state level or an equivalent institution/organization from the practical field (at least 24 weeks). Working on a practice-oriented question as part of a scientific work for 20 credits. In addition, attendance modules or online modules totaling 10 credits must be

completed (ideally to be collected in the first 2 semesters).

Option 2 Modules to be completed at your local university Achievements totaling 30 credits, of which 15 credits must correspond in content to the study objectives of Online Communication, Digital

Businesses or Online Marketing.

You receive your internationally accepted Master of Arts by Anhalt University of Applied Sciences. After your graduation you can stay 18 months in Europe to apply for a job.
